1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 THIS DOCUMENT:

Every participant of WT competition has to register on the WT GMS platform to compete.

The naming of the WT competitions should be always the same to keep and process consistent data.

With more than 50 yearly WT recognized competitions the WT want to apply a standard using English language for all the different inputs and outputs relative to the competition.

This document tries to follow as close as possible the Olympic standard of naming including necessary adaptations for all the Taekwondo competitions.

1.2 OBJECTIVE:

The objective of this document is to provide the same naming standard for all World Taekwondo Recognized and Promoted Championships.

The naming standard will standardize the data for the registration, the competition management and the results publication.

This document is complementary to the OVR specifications.

All the OVR and PSS providers must adapt their systems and services in order to be compliant with the WT Naming standard.

2.1 PARTICIPANT NAMES TO BE CAPTURED FOR REGISTRATION:

The participant name is divided into 2 categories including 2 parts as Family name and Given name:

- Passport Family name: OBAME
- Passport Given name: ANTHONY, MYLANN
- Preferred Family name: OBAME
- Preferred Given name: Anthony

- The Family name always uses upper case characters.
- The Given name always uses mixed case. The first letter is upper case and the following letters are lower case.

B – SPECIFICATION:

- The printed name is the concatenation of the preferred family name and the preferred given name.
- The printed name allows a maximum of 35 characters.

C – EXAMPLE :

- GONZALEZ BONILLA Joel

2.5 SCOREBOARD LONG NAME:**A – DESCRIPTION :**

The scoreboard long name is for display on the FOP scoreboard (Jumbo screen) and for the RTDS (Real time display system) at the venue.

B – SPECIFICATION :

- The scoreboard long name is the concatenation for the preferred family name and the preferred given name.
- The scoreboard long name depends on the scoreboard size.

C – EXAMPLE :

- Jingyu WU
- Daehoon LEE

2.6 SCOREBOARD SHORT NAME**A – DESCRIPTION :**

The scoreboard short name is for the display of the contestant name on the PSS (Protective scoring system) scoreboard.

B – SPECIFICATION :

- The PSS scoreboard name is the concatenation of the preferred family name all upper case and the first letter upper case of the preferred given name abbreviated with a . (dot)
- The scoreboard short name allows a maximum of 17 characters including . (dot) and (space).

C – EXAMPLE :

- JONES J.
- WU J.
- LEE D.
- KHODABAKHSHI M.
- GONZALEZ BONILLA

2.7 TV LONG NAME:**A – DESCRIPTION :**

The TV long name is always used by the TV graphics for the player presentation, historical results and results on graphical overlay before and after the contest.

B – SPECIFICATION :

- The TV long name is the concatenation for the preferred given name and the first letter upper case followed the preferred family name.
- Maximum of 35 characters

C – EXAMPLE :

- Jade JONES
- Jingyu WU
- Daehoon LEE
- Mahdi KHODABAKHSHI
- Joel GONZALEZ BONILLA

2.8 TV SHORT NAME:**A – DESCRIPTION :**

The TV short name is always uses by the TV graphics to display the contestant name on the graphical overlay during the contest.

B – SPECIFICATION :

- The TV short name is the concatenation of the first letter upper case of the preferred given name abbreviated with a . (dot) and the preferred family name.
- Maximum of 12 characters.

C – EXAMPLE :

- J. JONES
- J. WU
- D. LEE

- M. KHODABAK.
- J. GONZALEZ

2.9 CHARACTER SET FOR PARTICIPANT NAMES

The characters allowed for participants are ascii characters of the Roman alphabet. No accented characters are permitted.

The competition represents all the medal events of the same tournament.

The competition name is the concatenation of the host city, the year and the tournament name with a space in between.

The competition always uses mixed case. The first letter of each word is upper case and the following letters are lower case.

- Hammamet 2018 World Taekwondo Junior Championships
- Fujairah 2018 World Grand Prix Final
- Roma 2018 World Taekwondo Grand Prix series 1

DISCIPLINE :

The discipline represents the form of Taekwondo competition. The main abbreviation for Taekwondo as discipline is TKW. In order to add more details, the discipline concatenate Taekwondo and competition style.

The discipline always uses mixed case. The first letter of each words is upper case and the following letters are lower case.
